



Calvary Christian School Tuition & Fees Schedule 2017-2018

The following is a breakdown of tuition and fees at the various grade levels.

*Junior Kindergarten Students must be 4 by September 1, 2017.

Registration Fee - Returning Students Grades K-8:**

Account must be in good standing or an administrative approved plan must be in place to be eligible for reenrollment.

Enrolling: February 1 – February 28

Early bird registration fee \$125: Complete RenWeb Online Enrollment and submit registration fee

Enrolling: March 1 – March 31

Registration fee of \$250: Complete RenWeb Online Enrollment and submit registration fee.

Enrolling: April 1 – or later

Registration fee of \$350: Late re-enrollments are subject to availability.

****Re-enrollment fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.**

New Student Fees

Application Fee: A fee of \$25 per child is charged for students applying to CCS.

New Student Enrollment Fee Grades Kindergarten-8: A one-time enrollment fee (in lieu of a registration fee) of \$350 applies upon acceptance of each new student.

Junior-Kindergarten Enrollment Fee: An enrollment fee of \$250 applies upon acceptance of each pre-kindergarten student.

Tuition Discounts

Discounts apply only to tuition - all other fees and services are not discounted. Account must remain in good standing in order to receive a tuition discount.

Multiple Child Discounts: Full tuition is charged for the child enrolled at the highest grade level. Discounts for other children are applied on a descending grade level basis according to the following schedule:

2nd child	3rd child	4th child
10%	15%	20%

Tuition and Fee Payments: August 1, 2017 - May 1, 2018

- Option #1: Monthly Payments set up through FACTS (CCS Tuition Management System)
- Option # 2: Annual payment of tuition and fees in full by check or cash by August 10 will receive a 3% discount on tuition and select fees only – discount does not apply to credit card payments
- Option #3: Per Semester: one-half of annual tuition and fees are due by check or cash August 10 and January 10. You will receive a 3% discount on tuition and select fees only.

Please note: Credit card payments will no longer receive a discount.

Tuition Assistance

Families may inquire as to any available tuition assistance through the School Office. Tuition assistance is awarded based on financial need and availability. Tuition Assistance packets are due no later than May 15, 2017.

Partnership Discount – *for families who have been enrolled at CCS for a minimum of 1 year*

A \$250.00 credit, to be applied to January 2018 billing, will be awarded to a current CCS family who actively refers a new family to CCS. The new family must place referring family's name in referral line on application, enroll and remain current with tuition billing within a 4 month probationary period in order for the credit to be applied to the current family. ***Fees

Curriculum & Activity Fee: A fee of \$240 (or \$24/month on ten month schedule) is charged for each student to cover the cost of curriculum and designated student activities in each classroom.

Miscellaneous Fees: There are additional fees for 8th Grade Washington D.C. Trip, special field trips, student clubs, additional materials for specialized classes, competitive athletics, school pictures, cheerleading and music. *Miscellaneous Fees are billed through RenWeb.*

Calvary Christian Annual Fund

Tuition alone covers only approximately 80% of CCS' operating expenses. Each year everyone is encouraged to be involved with different fundraising efforts at the school like the Calvary Golf Outing and the Readathon. These efforts help support CCS operations for the year, allowing tuition to remain as low as possible. Our need is approximately \$200,000 annually.
